IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. Official Entries must be submitted electronically via the AWF website link www.awf.com.au/registration/ together with payment **no later than Sunday 14th February, 2016.**
2. Athletes must produce Photo ID at the weigh-in. Failure to produce ID will result in the athlete not being able to contest the event.
3. The 2016 Australian International can be contested by athletes who reside in Australia and overseas.
4. Athletes may compete in the category in which they have achieved qualification or go up or down categories. The category of choice must be declared at the verification of final entries held at 1800hrs on Thursday 17th March, 2016. Athletes can also change categories via email mkeelan@awf.com.au that must be received prior to 1800hrs on Thursday 17th March, 2016.
5. **Individual Placing** will be calculated off **Totals** only.
6. Any athlete not registering a result in the Snatch **will be** allowed to participate in the Clean & Jerk section of the competition but will not be eligible for medals or prizes.
7. **Prize money**
Men & Women
Overall 1st place - \$1000
Overall 2nd place - \$350
Overall 3rd place - \$150

Prize money will be determined by the Sinclair formula.
8. In the unlikely event that entries do not reach a minimum of 80 participants the event will be cancelled and entry fees will be refunded in full.
